

CONFERENCE TRAVEL GRANT

The association *Anthropology Southern Africa* has made available four conference travel grants up to the value of R2 000 each (plus a conference fees waiver) for the 2015 ASnA conference (see http://www.asnahome.org/asna-conferences/future-conference for details). The travel grants are intended for travel and accommodation (conference fees are waived).

Applications will be accepted for single applicants OR group applications.

The association will look favourably on group applications (up to the value of R2 000) that maximise the number of students attending. Note that only <u>one</u> conference fees waiver will apply per application.

Deadlines for submission of applications to the Treasurer:

The deadline is 20 July 2015

Committee Meeting Dates where awards are decided:

27 July 2015

Outcome date: no later than 1 week after committee meeting date

Eligibility:

- Full time post graduate students of anthropology registered at a Higher Education Institute in southern Africa
- Post doctoral students are ineligible
- Full time staff members are ineligible

Conditions:

- No incomplete, retrospective, ad hoc or late applications will be considered
- Awards are only made in the event that a paper is being presented
- Copies of the abstract, 2x airfare quotations or transportation quotes (such as vehicle hire and petrol for a group of students), a letter of support from your supervisor as well as the endorsements of the HoD need to accompany each application
- Conditional awards can be granted where proof of acceptance of a paper has not been obtained from the Conference organisers at the time of application. However, the proof will need to be provided **prior** to the funding being released
- Awards are granted for the *Anthropology Southern Africa* conference **only**. Should the conference be cancelled or the full amount allocated not utilised for any reason, then the funds must revert to ASnA and
- Please note: ASnA Conference travel funds should not be the sole source of funding for applicants.
- The committee strongly urges grant holders to submit a paper for the ASnA Monica Wilson Prize (see http://www.asnahome.org/monica-wilson-prize for details)
