



LECTURER (18 month contract)

The position has been vacant from 1 January 2016 and the School would like to make an appointment as soon as possible.

Anthropology at UCT has a strong record of teaching and research in Social-Cultural Anthropology, focusing largely but not exclusively on Southern Africa, with growing links across the Global South.

Requirements:

Applicants should have completed a PhD and have a growing publication record. Applicants should have the ability to teach at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The appointee should be willing, if needed, to take courses at UCT in tertiary level teaching methods so as to develop their teaching skills. Experience in supervising graduate students would be advantageous. Expertise in political/economic anthropology would be advantageous.

We will give preference to candidates with demonstrated research competence. Anthropology Section of AXL is also interested in expanding its range of teaching and research into new areas of contemporary anthropology.

Responsibilities:

- The incumbent will be responsible for curriculum design and course development as appropriate; for delivering lectures, seminar and tutorials; for taking on portfolio positions in the Section as agreed by the Section; for managing the Section's seminar series; for participating in the intellectual life of the School; for graduate supervision as appropriate to rank; for developing publications.
